THANK YOU FOR:



- **Wearing a mask**—masks are required in the galleries and theater, except when eating and drinking
- **Maintaining social distancing**—please keep six feet apart from people outside your pod
- **Washing your hands**—clean restroom facilities and hand sanitizing stations will be available in galleries and theater
- **Staying home if you are sick**—please stay home if you or a person you have been in contact with are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19

WHAT TCA HAS DONE:

- **HVAC upgrades**—CDC recommended HVAC air purifying filters positioned strategically throughout theater and galleries
- **Spaced Seating**—reduced theater and gallery capacity, requiring empty seats left between separate parties
- **Contactless ticketing**—tickets will be made available for purchase online and in advance
- **Limited concessions**
